What's accepted at a buyback center?

- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Glass bottles
- ✓ Plastic bottles
- ✓ Bi-metal cans

Make sure your bottles and cans say "CRV" or "CA Cash Refund."

The Waste Management Recycling Center, located at 16122 Construction Circle East, also accepts (without reimbursement) other recyclables such as non-CRV aluminum, non-CRV glass, non-CRV plastic, tin cans, newspaper, white ledger paper, computer paper, mixed paper and corrugated cardboard.

How much do I get back?

These centers provide California Redemption Value (CRV) reimbursement of:

- 5 cents for containers less than 24oz
- 10 cents for containers 24oz or more

Who's in charge of this program?






