












Cultural Terrace Priority Uses

Public Outreach 2004-2010 Community input from the early years

Focus groups/online and people-to-people polls/open-ended responses revealed features that were most popular, including:

- Large lake
- Museum district
- Nature landscape featuring trail systems
- Picnic and leisure area in forested environment
- Sports park and active recreating areas



Public Outreach 2004-2010

One survey's findings leaned toward facilities and amenities that were not otherwise generally available in parks:

- Hiking, walking, and running trails
- Outdoor performances, including music performance space/amphitheater
- Wildlife observation area and living park center/nature educational center



Public Outreach 2004-2010

Three symposium presentations included:

- Who does it serve?
- Who will use it?
- How to meet their needs?
- Build a park that looks forward to your children and grandchildren.
- What kind of 'house' does the public want from a design standpoint?
- The theme should be community, place, site and time.



Public Outreach 2004-2010

Overall strong support for active and passive uses (lakes and gardens, hiking and bikeways, to be combined with sports fields and playgrounds)
